Laminate CARE & MAINTENANCE



DAILY CLEANING

- Use a clean, damp non-abrasive cloth and a mild liquid detergent or household cleaner
- Carefully clean the seam area, do not allow a lot of liquid to penetrate near this area as it can cause the laminate to swell
- Dry the countertop surface with a clean, soft, and non-abrasive cloth



CARING FOR STAINS & SPILLS

Be sure to refer to the manufacturer's guidelines for the specific laminate surface you own; however, we recommend a few tips:

- Use an approved* full strength all-purpose cleaner or other mild household cleaners on the area immediately
- Be sure to blot the surface clean to prevent spreading the stain



Stubborn stains that may disappear on their own after repeated cleanings:

Coffee and tea

Food stains

Food dyes

Water marks

PREVENT DAMAGE

- Always use a cutting board. Do not ever chop or slice directly on the laminate surface.
- Be delicate with heavy items as the force from them may cause damage to the laminate surface
- Do not place hot objects directly on the laminate surface.
 Prolonged exposure to objects 140°F and greater can cause the laminate to separate. Always use a trivet, insulated hot pad, or other protective devices beneath all hot cookware, heatgenerating appliances, or other heated objects.
